E-9 & E-10: 1997: Coleman Engineering survey crew searched these two locations during the 1997 Dickinson County Remonumentation Program. No original evidence was recovered. E-9: 1998: Again no original evidence was recovered. This corner was established from GLO river calls West and South, Swamp calls East and checked with course and distance of ascend ledge call to the North. Proportionate measurement was rejected as the method of reestablishment because, during the course of the survey from the SW corner of Section 33 (E-13) to the SW corner of Section 16 (E-7) It was found that the distance was over 3 chains long. Based on the distances between GLO line calls, most of this overage occurs North of the stream between E-7 and E-8. Also if strictly proportionate measure had been used for the North-South location of E-9 this would have placed it well North of the swamp to the East, which is called in the GLO notes. This same situation would have occurred with the corner position 1 mile to the South. After establishing the location of E-9, using the above mentioned line calls, it was found that the distances in the random line, field notes acquired from the DNR office in Baraga agreed reasonably with 1998 measurements to the corners 1 mile North and 1 mile East. Furthermore when this position was used to establish the North-South position of E-11 it was found to be in agreement with the GLO record. E-10: 1998: Again no original evidence was recovered and this corner was established by proportionate measure between E-9 and E-11. This position is in agreement with the GLO record.
