

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

COUNTY REPRESENTATIVE

E-7; Section Corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21, T40N, R29W;

Found a 1" x 42" galvanized iron pipe with a 4" brass cap as set by Mr. DeLaMater in 1954 alongside a 2" x 36" iron pipe. Mr. DeLaMater's monument was found to be in agreement with his new bearing trees as described in Part A. Replaced Mr. DeLaMater's monument with a standard county monument described in Part C. Accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- E-7; Section Corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21, T40N, R29W;

Set a 5/8" x 36" aluminum rod with a 3" aluminum cap stamped as to location projecting 4" above the ground.

All of the above new bearing trees are marked with upper and lower blazes. The lower blaze is scribed "NBT". Both blazes as well as a band around the tree at the upper blaze are painted red.
