Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(All) 1962 corner monument was not recovered. Restored the corner at record bearing and distance from the 1962 MBTs as follows: Bard Maple M212 found in good condition, Mard Maple M19V has been cut down, Aspen 304V in dead but standing. At the position for the corner 1 placed a 1° 1.0.x12° iron pipe projecting 12° and capped with a yellow plastic cap stamped D.W.R. LS 33936. Marked 3 new bearing trees as described below.

(All) Set 1° pipe with plastic cap. Blased and acribed the following new
