A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(87) Quarter corner common to Sections 18-19. Corner established in 1850 by John Burt as follows: Set cedar qr. section post. Tamarack 8 541E 23, Spruce 10 M8M 19. Found no subsequent record.

(8-Sec. 18) West 1/16 corner Secction 18. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(87) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the corner at the position proportionate to the original record, on a straight line and at the midpoint between sections corners 2651.46' east and west. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"I.D.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(8-Sec. 18) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at 20 chains, proportionate to the original record (mean of north and south lines of Sec. 18) west of the Center of Section 1312.29' east, and on a straight line between Center and quarter corner 1296.55' west. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"I.D.x32" from pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.
