- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- (17) Corner common to Sections 14-15-22-23. Corner reestablished and filed in 1967 by F.J. Bray, RLS as follows: Reestablished by double proportionate measurement between sec. cors. 1 mile north, south and west and 2 miles to east. Placed 1° iron pipe with 4° aluminum cap. Witnesses: 12" Elm W71E 12.5 links, 10" Elm S75W 37 links. Found no subsequent record. (2-Sec. 22) East 1/16 corner between Sections 15-22. Corner established and filed in 1967 by F.J. Bray, RLS as follows: This corner placed midway and on line bet. 1/4 cor to west and sec. cor to east. Corner monument - 1° iron pipe with 4° aluminum cap. Mitnesses: 12" Elm M46E 11 links, 12" Elm M64W 13.5 links. Found no subsequent record.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(17) Found the monument as described above, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the remaining NBT: 10° alm SBOM 24.4', now dead. The other alm is now a badly deteriorated stump. Left the monument in place and marked 4 new mitnesses as described

(2-Sec. 22) found the monument noted above at record bearing and distance from the stump remains of the Ela bearing tree NGAN. The other elm MBT is dead and down. The aluminum cap has been broken off of the monument, but it is otherwise in good condition. Left the pipe in place and earked 4 new witnesses as described below. Found a 3/8° iron rod set by unknown persons, with the remains of a plastic cap, apparently chewed on by some animal, N78E 3.1' distant.
