B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(12-Sec. 24) Found the 1978 monument, as described, M82M 30.2 distant from the 1978 corner position. The monument was likely moved to this erroneous location by an adjacent land owner as the position at which it was found alleviates a cabin encroachment. Both 1978 bearing trees were recovered. The Cedar NN is in good condition with scribing visible, the Cedar SN is a 1 1/2 tall stump with scribing visible. At the 1978 position for the corner, at record bearing and distance from the recorded BTs, I placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped, set 4" below the surface at the £. edge of a two-track trail. No measurements were made to other corners at this time. Corner monumented by 8.Mheeler and D.Lampela, 8araga District Office, MDNR. The 1978 monument found at the improper position was removed.
