F-1 5/8 inch iron pin found 14 inches below surface of road. Pin in line with old fence to the south and the edge of the field to the north.

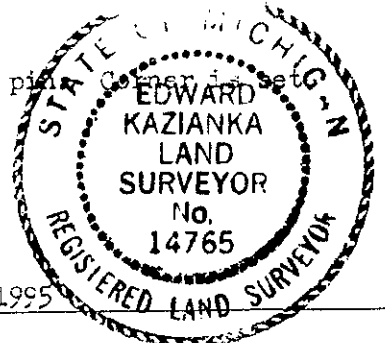

E-1 Set a Dickinson County Survey cap/rod six inches below surface of county road. Corner is set 24 feet north of the witness corner.  
Cedar 12 S16W 60.24 feet. B. Ash 8 S44W 54.55 feet. Witness corner South 24.00 feet.  
Aspen 6 S25E 32.15 feet. P.Pole N69W 77.27 feet.

F-1 Set a Dickinson County Survey cap/rod in place of 5/8 inch iron pin. Corner is set six inches below surface of road.

Spruce 20 N56E 65.10 feet. Balsam 7 S57E 52.35 feet.  
Y. Birch 7 S44W 36.65 feet. Maple 4 S09W 25.75 feet.
