Replaced corner from two probable original cedar bearing trees. Cedar approximate 8" S 31 E 15 links in place, down, with plain overgrowth scar of description blaze, axemarks plain. Remains of cedar 10" N 42 W 20 links in place with no identifying marks. Distance checks good ½ chain to west to swamp edge. Squared white pine near by for approximate corner. Wood post near by placed by Kimberly Clark cruisers.

Corner found while cruising timber in this area with Norman J. Karsten.

Corner placed and witnessed on 7 August 1958 with Norman J. Karsten.
