[18] Quarter corner common to Sections 14-15. Original corner established in 1848 by Marvey Mellen as follows: Set coder post.

[7-Sec. 15] North 1/18 corner between Sections 14-15. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (60) Remonmented the corner at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees: White pine stumps of proper size in advanced stages of decay M24E 24 links, and S27W 4 links. He markings visible. The stungs should evidence of heavy burning. Stream crossing to south and Enter Swamp to morth check as recorded above. Found no trace of the Ceder line tree. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"[.8.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dis. cost aluminum HBMR tablet, appropriately stamped.
- (IS) Original past and accessories not recovered. Found no monumentation at the corner position. Found as acceptable evidence on the pround of the position of the original corner. Reestablished the corner midway and on a straight line between monumented section corners 2850.85' north and south. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"1.9.x32" from pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDMM tablet, appropriately stamped.

(7-Sec. 15) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner on a straight line between Section corner 1325.33' North and Quarter corner 1325.33' South.
