January 21, 1913</u>, 19 \_\_\_\_\_, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with requisitions and rules therefore as required in the current menual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in times 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(LT) Quarter corner common to Sections 13 and 24. Cedar post placed for corner in original survey, 1850. BTs: Cedar 8 570M 10, Spruce 10 M66£ 18. Found no subsequent record.

(LB) Center of Section 24. Corner not established in original survey. Found no subsequent record.

[19] Buarter corner common to Sections 24 and 25. Cedar post placed for corner in original survey, 1850. BTs: Spruce 6 S70N 50, Cedar 8 N70E 25. Found no subsequent record.

8. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(17) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no evidence on the ground of the original corner location. Reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record between section corners 2643.75' east and mest, both of record.

(18) Found no evidence of prior monumentation or evidence of use at corner location. Established corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/4 corners, all as recorded this date.

(19) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no evidence of the original corner location on the ground. Found a single coder stump in corner area, but no markings of any kind visible. Reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record between section corners 2649.14' mest and east, the easterly section corner location being determined from the mitness corner recorded in 1985.
