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- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- (E9) Corner common to Sections 20-21-28-29. Corner remonumented at the original position as determined from the remains of two original bearing trees in 1952 by Dean C. DelaMater, RLS. He placed a 1° iron pipe with a 4° Brass cap at the corner and marked as a witness a 9° Balsan NOSE 29 links.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (E9) Found the 1952 monument a 1° dia. Iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. brass Michigan Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1952 Balsan witness, now dead, and at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original Codar bearing trees. The Codar ME being a stump in good condition, that SM being gound level remains. Left the monument in place and marked four new witnesses as described below.
