A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
Nest 1/16 corner between Sections 30-31. Corner established in 1963 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS: "This corner was placed midway and on a line between Section Corner to West and 1/4 Corner to East. Placed 1" pipe with 4" aluminum cap. Mitnesses to corner, 9" 8. Cherry M68W 19 links, 6° W. Birch \$20E 12.5 links". Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Renonumented the postion established in 1963 by Buckler. Recovered both 1963 bearing trees, in good condition. Scribing is visible on the lower blaze of the Cherry, and the overgrown lower blaze of the Birch was chopped out to reveal the original marks. The 1963 monument was not recovered. Placed a new monument, a 1"I.D.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, at record bearing and distance from the 1963 bearing trees.
