B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(A7) Recovered the 1969 monument as described, a 1" I.D. iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum HDMR tablet, in good condition. and at record bearing and distance from the remaining 1969 MBT, the Red Haple NE. The other maple MBT was apparently removed during construction of a M-S read, the centerline of which is about 12' east of the corner. My measurements to the corners noted above are 159.63 ch. South and 79.89 ch. North. I accepted the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Left the monument in place and marked 3 new mitnesses as described below. There is a gate on the above mentioned road whose mestarly gate post is 8' east and 3' south of the monument. Corner remitnessed by D.Lampela and B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office. MDNR.

(A3) Recovered the 1968 monument, as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1968 witnesses, both in good condition.
