1. POST SET IN ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT SURVEY BY HERVEY PARKE, DEPUTY SURVEYOR ON JANUARY 18, 1826 WITH THE FOLLOWING WITNESSES: W. OAK 8" N36-1/2°W .36 (23.8') ELM 22" S37-1/2°E .34 (22.4')

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

SEARCHED AT APPARENT LOCATION OF CORNER AND FOUND 1/2" BAR AND CAP LS 25832 ON THE WEST SIDE OF AN ANCHOR POST AND PROVED IT TO BE IN THE POSITION RECORDED BY BRYAN BY ALL THREE OF HIS WITNESSES (ITEM 3). THE CAPPED BAR IS IN THE ROOTS OF A 40" MAPLE. TRAVERSED SECTION 6 IN BOOK HM1 PAGES 14-25 AND 28-29 AND FOUND THAT DISTANCE FROM C-2 TO C-1 IS INDEED IN CLOSE ACCORD WITH A.N. BATEMAN'S MEASURED DISTANCE (ITEM 2). DID NOT EXCAVATE BECAUSE DOING SO WOULD ENTAIL DESTROYING THE 40" MAPLE. I THINK THE ANCHOR POST IS GOOD EVIDENCE OF THE CORNER POSITION AND ALSO THAT IT IS CLOSE ENOUGH TO USE THE POSITION OF THE BAR ALONGSIDE THE ANCHOR POST AS THE CORNER POINT. REMOVED THE 1/2" BAR AND SET STANDARD MARKER FOR PA 345 REMONUMENTATION IN EATON COUNTY IN SAME POSITION.
