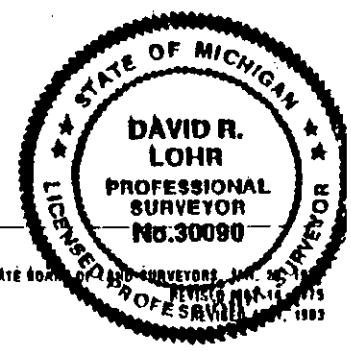

 NORTHEAST CORNER SCHOOL NORTHWEST 104.3' DATED MAY 4, 1922
 SOUTHWEST CORNER SCHOOL NORTHWEST 106.8'

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- COMMON WITNESSES TO SCHOOL BUILDING IN NORTHWEST DIRECTION ARE COMMON ON 1922 MARGINAL NOTES AND 1958 ROAD COMMISSION CONSTRUCTION PLANS. HAND EXCAVATED INTERIOR OF MONUMENT BOX AND FOUND 1" STEEL BAR AT DEPTH OF 19" BELOW 3/4" PIPE. AT DEPTH OF 30" FOUND LARGE STONE. THIS STONE IS BELIEVED TO BE THE SAME STONE AS NOTED IN 1876. (ITEM #3, PART A.) THE 3/4" PIPE IS ACCEPTED BASED ON 1958 WITNESSES TO SCHOOL AND IDENTIFICATION AS A 3/4" PIPE. ITS LOCATION IS SUPPORTED BY LOCATION OF STONE 30" DEEP. 1988 DISTANCE SHOWN ON SURVEY 860-L (ITEM 8-PART A) OF 2648.09' MATCHES STATIONING SHOWN ON 1958 PLANS. STATIONING DISTANCE IS SHOWN TO BE 2648.18'.
 - FOUND 3/4" PIPE IN MONUMENT BOX.
 - 3/4" PIPE IN ACCEPTED AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER
