FOUND 1/2" SOLID IRON 10.27 FEET NORTH OF IRON APPARENTLY REPRESENTING M-5, T1N R7W, ABOUT 1' BELOW GRAVEL ROAD GRADE, APPROXIMATING POSITION DESCRIBED BY CARR IN ITEMS 3, 4, 5, AND 6 OF PART "A" ABOVE. DISTANCE REPORTED BY GENERAL LAND OFFICE (EVANS, ITEM 1 ABOVE) AND BY DAVIS 1870 (ITEM 2 ABOVE) ARE PROFOUNDLY DIFFERENT.
