FOUND A "T" BAR FENCE POST AT THE STANDARD CORNER OF M-10 IN VERY CLOSE ACCORD WITH BEING AT THE MIDPOINT OF M-9 AND M-11 OF EATON TWP. EXCAVATED A 4' SQUARE HOLE 2.5 TO 3 FEET DEEP BELOW SAND AT M-10. AREA APPEARS TO BE A ROAD CUT AND WE COULD NOT FIND ANY SUPPORTING EVIDENCE. EXCAVATED IN THE PROBABLE LOCATION OF A-10 AND FOUND SAND OVER CLAY ROAD BED AND LITTLE ELSE. ACCEPTED THE T-BAR FENCE POST AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE FOR M-10 AND SET A 3/4" BY 24" FORM PIN ON LINE BETWEEN M-11 AND M-10 AND AT THE MIDPOINT BETWEEN A-11 AND A-9 PER G.L.O. INSTRUCTIONS.

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
