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- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: FOUND 1/2" IRON BAR AT LOCATION AND EXCAVATED DOWN TO PIPES AS DESCRIBED IN 1948 CONSUMERS POWER WITNESSES. DID NOT FIND THE 1 1/2" PIPE AS DESCRIBED BY L.A. BRYAN IN HIS LIBER 4, PGS. 900-901 SURVEY. THE WITNESSES FROM THE C.R.C. WERE OBLITERATED. FOUND THE POWER POLES AS WITNESSED BY SURVEYORS BRYAN & LESTER AND THE HEADSTONE NOTED BY LESTER. THE 1/2" PIPE AS NOTED BY LESTER & BRYAN WAS MUSHROOMED & COULD HAVE BEEN MISTAKEN AS A BOAT SPIKE.
