FOUND 1/2" IRON REPRESENTING STANDARD CORNER AS PER LCRC #462 (ITEM #3 ABOVE). CONFIGURATION OF ROADS MADE IT UNCLEAR WHETHER THE IRON WAS INTENDED TO REPRESENT THE STANDARD OR CLOSING CORNER. TRAVERSED 2 1/2 MILES OF RANGE LINE FROM A-13 TO A 8, AND ENOUGH OF SECTION 30, TYING IN OCCUPATION LINES APPARENTLY BASED ON CHURCH'S SURVEY (ITEM 3 ABOVE) AND "BACKED IN" POSITION OF CLOSING CORNER BASED ON THOSE MEASUREMENTS. CLOSING CORNER FELL 10+/- FEET SOUTH OF IRON RECORDED BY BONNEMA. EXCAVATED WITH BACKHOE AN AREA 20' N-S BY 10' E-W TO A DEPTH OF 4+ FEET IN SEARCH OF OTHER MONUMENTATION FOR BOTH STANDARD AND CLOSING CORNERS, FOUND NOTHING.
