FOUND 5/8" IRON AND ALL WITNESSES BY BONNEMA (#4 OF PART "A") FOR STANDARD CORNER. ALSO FOUND WITNESSES BY DAVIS, AND IRON FOR CLOSING CORNER PROFOUNDLY DISTURBED BY INSTALLATION OF UNDERGROUND TELEPHONE CABLE. RESTORED DAVIS POSITION FROM WITNESSES; RESTORED POSITION FIT REASONABLY WELL WITH DAVIS' CALL FOR 18.05 FEET SOUTH OF BARRY CORNER. EXCAVATED AN AREA OF 8' x 30' x 3' CENTERED ON THE FOUND IRON AT M-11 BY BONNEMA AND RESTORED POSITION OF A-11 BY DAVIS. FOUND NO STONE REPRESENTING EITHER CORNER; HOWEVER, FOUND A LARGE NUMBER OF PIECES OF RED AND WHITE BRICK WIDELY SCATTERED GENERALLY IN A NORTH-SOUTH DIRECTION, PROBABLY DISTRIBUTED BY A ROAD GRADER.
