- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 - J-11, Investigation at this corner location revealed a 3/4" pipe in a monument box 2' South of the centerline Rossman Highway on old fence North. A MDSH tag in power pole was found from Item #3 above as well as a bark scar in a 20" Maple at ±42.5' and 1/2 of what was the twin 12" Willow Southeast at ±88'. A 3/4" bar and cap #11370 was also found North, 33.01'. Measured distance East to K-11 was 2643.70', the distance as shown on MDSH notes by Wetoskey was 2643.66'. Dug in bottom of monument box to a depth of 3 1/2 feet and found 1 1/4" pipe underneath 3/4" pipe as noted in item #3. Also found a large rock in Northwest part of monument box along with several pieces of crockery.
