B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

K-11, Investigation at this corner revealed a 3/4" pipe and cap #11370in monument box in centerline of Hartel Road and Shance Highway. 30" Ash, East 45.64' which matches direction, distance and type of tree from item #10 and direction and type of tree from item #6. All other witnesses listed were not found. This area excavated by Richard W. Steadman on January 22, 1974 as noted in item #6 and no further excavation was done.
