Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

M-10, T3N, R4W

- 1. Post set in Original Government Survey by Lucius Lyon, Deputy Surveyor, in 1826, Beech 20 S21°W 46, Beech 16, N48°W 31.
- 2. Corner identified in a survey by O.G. Church, County Surveyor, on March 23, 1876 (vol. 2, page 26 and 27 County Surveyor Records) as a "stake from original survey and bearing tree", with no new witnesses given. (Continued on Back)
- B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

M-10, Investigation at this corner revealed a 1/2" pinched pipe 0.20' below gravel surface 3.0' East of the centerline of Royston Road and 3.0' North of the centerline of King Highway. Excavated hole 2.0'x 2.0' centered on pinched pipe to a depth of 3.0' but found nothing. All witnesses except one from item #4 were found. Measured North 2639.38 feet to M-9 Benton Township and South 2661.71 to M-11 Benton Township. Replaced pinched pipe with 3/4" bar and cap stamped P.A. 345 #25832 and witnessed location. At the direction of the Eaton County Peer Review Group, further investigation at this corner was needed to prove or disprove the 20 foot discrepancy in the distance measured South to M-11 Benton Township.

Kay D. Fluke P.S. #18988 stated that he found part of a plow beam set by M.H. Bailey for A-10 Windsor Township in item #3, ±20.0 feet South of the pinched pipe for M-10 above. Measured North and South from plow beam to M-11 and M-9 Benton Township to determine best Measured North and South from plow beam to M-11 and M-9 Benton Township to determine best location to dig for M-10. The midway point between M-11 and M-9 is ±12.0 feet North of A-10. This location is in a ±3.0 fcot cut area. Excavated area 3.0' x 3.0' by 1.0' deep to original soil but found no evidence of stake from item #2. Corner considered lost. Plow beam is 0.07 feet West of a line between M-9 and M-12 Benton Township. Accepted plow beam as the best evidence of the location of the township line. Set corner at mid point between M-11 and M-9 Benton Township on line with A-10 Windsor Township and M-9 Benton Township. Corner falls 12.18 feet North of A-10 Windsor Township. Measured North and South to M-9 and M-11 Benton Township 2646.85 (Recorded 2640.00 feet GLO distance). Set 3/4" x 24" bar with cap stamped P.A. 345 #25832, 12.18 feet North of A-10, Windsor Township. Removed cap from 3/4" bar and cap noted earlier in Part "B"and left in place.
