3 Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

M-13, Investigation at this corner revealed a 2" angle iron just below gravel surface of road. Found nail & tag #25832 in West side of a power pole Southwest 63.65' and a large Maple/Oak East Northeast 84.33' from items #8, and #9 along with a 20" Maple Northeast 37.22' from items #7, #8 and #9. Removed angle iron and excavated a hole 2.0'x 2.0' down 3.0' to natural ground but found nothing else. Measured North to M-12 Benton Township 2634.66 feet (Recorded 2634.72 feet County Surveyor Records). West to L-13 Benton Township 2643.86 feet (Recorded 2640.00 feet County Surveyor Records).
