- County Surveyor's Records Volume 1, Page 38 shows a survey by W.D. Southworth, County Surveyor, on March 26, 1867 in which he used the corner. No monumenation or measurements given.
- County Surveyor's records Volume 1, Page 55 shows a survey which appears to be in W.D. Southworth, County Surveyor's handwriting during May 1869 in which the corner was used. Corner measured 133 rods from C-2. Monumentation not mentioned.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found T-Iron in centerline Needmore Highway (Gravel Rd.) and on occupation/cropline/treeline South. All recorded witnesses obliterated. Excavated a 3.5' diameter pit around T-Iron. Encountered original clay soil ±2' below surface. Proceeded down another foot. Found no evidence of prior monumentation. Accepted location of T-Iron as location of corner. Distance to C-13 is in close proximity to GLO falling. Distance between C-1 and C-2 as computed from a traverse of the section (2192.59') is in close accordance with same distance as measured by Surveyor Orange Risdon (2194.50') which was in close accordance with same distance as set by Deputy
Surveyor Orange Risdon (2197.14'). Set a 3/4" iron form pin with 2 1/2" diameter aluminum P.A. 345 Cap
#28414 in place of the T-Iron. Set a monument box around and witnessed.
