- 5. Act 132 survey recorded in Liber 1, Page 528 529, on April 11, 1982 by Austin Williams, RLS #21275, gives no description of corner but has the same witnesses as A-4.
- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Found 1/2" x 18" Iron Rebar with Cap # 18988 (Kay Don Fluke) 2" below asphalt surface of Chester Road. Iron falls 1.6' East of Centerline of Chester Road on extension of East & West tree line. Found nail and Tag #18988 N. Side of 30" Hickory, N84°E, 38.10 feet. Also found nail and tag #18988 in top of 20" Stump S29°W, 64.20 feet. Excavated 2'x2' hole at a depth of 2.5 feet. Found no other evidence. At the direction of the Eaton County Remonumentation Peer Review Committee, a larger excavation was performed. A 3.5' by 4.5' by average depth of 12" hole was dug. Found a 3 1/2" inside diameter hexagon clay tile standing upright. Clay tile falls 1.2' north and 0.5 'west of 1/2" rebar location. The clay tile was left in position and a 3/4" by 24" iron rod with cap stamped "P.A. 345 P.S. 28414" was placed in the center of clay tile. Placed a monument box over the tile and rod. This surveyor believed that the clay tile is the perpetuation of the corner position from previous surveyors. Measured North 2657.67 to E-7 and
