NEAR THE IRON/MONUMENT BOX AT 2.5 FEET BELOW THE OLD ROAD GRADE, THEY FOUND A STONE AND SEVERAL PIECES OF ORANGE BRICK (WILLIAM'S STONE, SEE ITEM A-3). THIS MACHINE EXCAVATION EXTENDED TO THE SOUTH OF FLUHARTY'S BAR BY ABOUT 20' AND AT LEAST 12 FEET EAST AND WEST OF IT. FLUHARTY'S BAR WAS REMOVED AND NOT REPLACED DURING THIS WORK. NO OTHER EVIDENCE OF SURVEY MONUMENTATION WAS FOUND IN THE EXCAVATION. BELIEVE THE STONE AT THE NEARBY CLOSING SECTION CORNER (A-9) IS THE BEST EVIDENCE OF THE LOCATION OF THE STANDARD TOWNSHIP LINE. RE-ESTABLISHED POSITION FOR M-9 AT 38.3 FEET SOUTH OF WILLIAM'S STONE ON EXTENSION OF A LINE FROM THE POSITION RECENTLY DETERMINED BY ME FOR THE STANDARD CORNER 1/2 MILE NORTH (M-8) THROUGH WILLIAM'S STONE (A-9 CHESTER).
