B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 2" Bar± 3' North of Centerline Needmore Hwy. (gravel) and on East edge Parker Road (gravel). Bar was ±20' East of the South end of a North-South treeline running South from Needmore Hwy. Found Witnesses: Nail & Tag #16053 in North side Utility Pole S 54.1 W (Distance not measurable due to heavy brush). Nail and fragment of a tag (number ends with "34") North side of beforementioned utility pole, 0.3' above Nail and Tag #16053. Also found a nall hole 0.4' above nail and tag fragment. Dug a 4' x 4' area. At about one foot below surface encountered the stones that were mentioned in A. #4 & #5 around the Iron. Stones were roundish and medium-sized (30-40 lbs.) At 2' below surface, removed the 2" iron. Iron measured 2.4' in length. Dug to a total depth of 3.5' and found no evidence of prior monumentation. Set a 3/4" x 24" Iron rod with 2 1/2" diameter aluminum cap stamped P.A. 345, #28414 in location of 2" iron. Set rod measures 134.53 feet West from E-1 Chester Twp. as recorded in Liber 3, Page 548. Accepted position of found iron as best perpetuated location based on area surveyors.
