B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

FOUND 3/4" X 36" PIPE 2'+/- EAST OF NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE AND 4'+/- NORTH OF EAST-WEST CENTERLINE. ONLY ONE WITNESSES BY STEADMAN REMAINS (ITEM #8 PART "A") (MAPLE SOUTHWEST), ALL OTHERS ARE GONE. TRAVERSE OF THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 33 SHOWS G-12 (FOUND 1/2" CAPPED IRON BY BRYAN ITEM #10 PART "A") TO BE AT THE MID POINT AND ON LINE AS NOTED IN SURVEY BY BRYAN. DISTANCE FROM FOUND G-11 TO FOUND E-11 IS 5264.16 FEET MEASURED, NOTED BY MOORED (ITEM #9 PART "A") 5264.05 FEET. EXCAVATED AROUND FOUND PIPE RECORDED BY STEADMAN AND USED BY BRYAN AND MOORED TO A DEPTH OF 1.5'+/-FOUND 2 PLOW POINTS STANDING UPRIGHT, ONE ON EACH SIDE OF FOUND PIPE, WITH BITS OF BROKEN GLASS AROUND THEM. ACCEPTED FOUND PIPE BETWEEN FOUND PLOW POINTS AND GLASS AS TRUE CORNER POSITION PERPETUATED BY COUNTY SURVEYOR FRANK DAVIS AND BY STEADMAN, USED BY BRYAN AND MOORED. REPLACED FOUND PIPE WITH STANDARD EATON COUNTY REMONUMENTATION MONUMENT WITH ALUMINUM CAP STAMPED "31602". LEFT PLOW POINTS AND GLASS IN PLACE.
