Dug below and found no evidence of Keep's 6" square Post with Charcoal at bottom. Found 1/2" rerod, no. 15401 at 1.5' west of single proportionate position. Used the 1/2" Rerod as the best available evidence of the corner. **FOUND WITNESSES** 5) S84°E (Az.96°) Tele. Post, 15402 cap/nail in south face 44.00 7) N87°W (Az.273°) 70.82' record, 70.76' measure 10" Apple, PK-nail in north face C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: F5, CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 9, & 16, T34N, R5W The 1/2" Rerod noted above was removed, and replaced with a 2" diameter, 30" long, PVC pipe with a base magnet and a standard brass Emmet County Survey Remonumentation Program cap, which was placed within a standard Emmet County monument box.
