

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Abstract: GLO set corner in 1840's. Keep found corner in 1914.

Robinson or Lee found corner and set concrete monument. Miller found concrete monument and notes finding original bearing trees. There appears to be question by Miller and Bidstrup about the concrete monument and its relationship to the GLO bearing trees. It has been used in subsequent surveys by local surveyors.

Found: Concrete monument, fimly set in swampy area, with Emmet County Standard Cap, very old fence W.
