do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

H-7, Quarter Corner common to Section 15 & 22, T35N R5W abstract. GLO established corner in 1840s. Perpetuated by M. Palmer in 1902. Circa 1954 highway notes show approximate location only. In 1960 Ted Miller PS in corner registry No. (35-5) 15-7 states a Railroad Spike in old pavement centerline accepted as corner. Local testimony states that Railroad Spike replaced concrete pad with 34" pipe and marked 14 corner when concrete was laid. Numerous surveys from 1960 to current show 1" pipe in road centerline, which perpetuates Miller's Corner registry.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found and verified 1" Pipe. Verified T-iron west and Concrete monument east. Further verified house witness (2). Miller perpetuated corner very well in corner registry.


