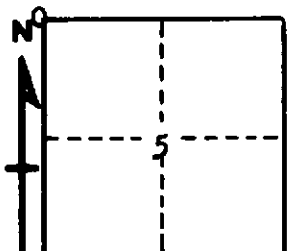

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER Section corner common to Sections 5 - 6 - 31 - 32

CORNER MONUMENT Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

This corner was found while making a survey in this area. Found 3/4" iron bar at corner, as established in a 1928 survey by Fred Soll, R.L.S., for Department of Conservation, during a boundary survey of Wilderness State Park. Four of Soll's NBTs in place. Considered best available evidence of proper location for this corner. Nothing left for U.S.BTs.
