Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1823, GLO - Harvey Parke, D.S., set wood post and two accessories, measured E-5 to E-4 and E-4 to E-3 1996, Certified survey - L.. 3473, P. 244-245 by Mark L. VanRaemdonck P.S. #24622, no description of monument given, no

accessories given, measured E-4 to E-5

1996, Certified survey - L.. 3473, P. 246-248 by Mark L. VanRaemdonck P.S. #24622, no description given, no accessories given, measured E-4 to E-3

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1999 Remon - Found iron and cap #24622, 0.20 feet west of fence corner post, fence runs north and west.

In the 1823 GLO survey by Harvey Parke, D.S. a wood post is indicated as the corner with two measurements, E-5 to E-4, 40 chains (2640 feet), In 1999 I measure 2676. 07 feet, E-4 to E-3, 40 chains (2640 feet), 1999 I measure 2654.23 feet. In a 1996 Certified survey by Mark VanRaemdonck, RLS #24622 recorded on L. 3473, P. 244-245 with one measurement shown E-4 to E-5 of 2676.53 feet, (0.46 feet longer than 1999 measurement), and E-4 to E-3 of 2654.23 feet, (0.25 feet shorter than 1999 measurement).

Today in the 1999 remonumentation program I am finding an iron and cap #24622 (Mark L. VanRaemdonck) as the corner. I excavated down approximately three feet and found no remnants of previous monumentation. This corner falls in an area of old farm fields with little evidence of previous surveys. No County Surveyor records were found for this corner. I looked in the proportionate measure location and found no evidence indicating the corner should fall in a different location. I accept this corner as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

North 115.63' found iron and cap #24622 N70°W 26.13' found spike and tag #24622 in S. face 10" twin Walnut West 25.27' Set spike and Genesee County Remonumentation tag in South face 36" 4' high stump S45°W 84.95' found iron and cap #24622
