

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Measured between corners I-3 and I-4, 2657.98 feet and I-4 and I-5, 2639.06 feet. Found T-iron #6100 and large (1.5 fee and 0.8 feet x 1.5) stone with a ridge like top to it with a high point on it. Accessories measured from the found T-iron.

In the 1823 GLO survey, John Mullet set a wood post and listed two accessories. Two measurements, I-5 to I-4, 4C chains (2640) and I-4 to I-3, 40 chains (2640). In 1872, S.R. Billings (county surveyor) found the original corner and set a stake. Mr. Billings measured from J-4 to I-4 a distance of 39.85 chains (2630.10 feet). No survey records were found from 1872 to 1993. In 1993, Flint Surveying and Engineering found a T-bar at the corner. Of the four listed accessories only one remains and it checks within 0.08 feet. Measurements I-4 to I-5 = 2639.12 feet, I-4 to I-3 = 2658.07 feet and I-4 to J-4 = 2642.25 feet. In 1997, Gilbert Bonno, P.S., recorded an Act 132 survey, L. 3688, P. 860, found the T-bar and listed five accessories, all of which were found and checked within 0.01 feet to 0.05 feet of record. Measurements from I-4 to I-3 a distance of 2662.97 feet which is 4.90 feet more than the 1993 record distance and which is 4.99 feet more than the present measurement. Measurement from I-4 to J-4 was 2633.62 feet which is 3.52 feet more than the 1993 record distance.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Today in the 1999 remonumentation program, I am finding a T-bar #6100 at occupation with fences to the North, East and West. Said corner is also approximately 30 feet north of the centerline of an E-W lane. Upon excavation of this corner, a large stone was found 1.08 feet west of and 0.66 feet North of the found T-bar. The found stone is 1.5 feet in length by 0.8 feet wide and was found laying on its side. I held the position of the T-bar, since there were no records of a stone being set at this corner. I accept the found T-bar as the best available evidence of the original corner.
