(1920's-1930's) but I did not find any evidence of a post, pipe or stones. It is possible that the twin 14" Oak to the SE is an entirely South of the corner position and it is possible that the twin 8" tree that Mr Mitchell was referring to was removed during the construction of the drive. The power pole mentioned in the 1920's-1930's GCRC witnesses to the South of the corner unfortunately does not indicate of the cut-off pole (which is +/- 6" above ground level) and the old GCRC measurement.
