

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1821 GLO - J. Wampler, Set post and 2 accessories

GCRC Road Plans Dwg. #730 - No description of monument given; 1/4 line shown intersecting with Saginaw Road Webber Place Plat - No description of monument given; corner shown on centerline of Judd Road 148.5' W of centerline of 1922 Saginaw Street.

GCRC Road Plans Dwg. 31017 - No description of monument given; shown at intersection of Judd Road & Saginaw Street; C-1925 12, B-12 2643.2°

MSHD Witnesses - Large stone raised with 3/4" pipe. 1965

LCRC L.1820, P.330 N.C. Jones - 1" pipe in monument box. 1971

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: B.

1998 Remon
Fnd 1" pipe in centerline Judd Road and 147' west of centerline of Saginaw Road, 8" below surface. In 1821, J. Wampler, D.S. set a post and two accessories for corner C-12, 40 chains (2640 feet) North of corner C-13. None of the accessories exist in 1998. In 1998 Rowe measures 26% 62 feet from corner C-13 to C-12. In 1922 the Plat of Webber Place was recorded and shows corner C-12 in the centerline of Judd Road 148.5' West of the centerline of Saginaw Street. 1998 147 feet West of centerline of Saginaw Street. Genesee County records (no date) indicate a brick and stake with two accessories. Neither of which exist in 1998. In 1965 MSHD witnesses indicate a large stone raised with a 3/4" pipe. Four accessories are shown two of which exist in 1998 which check very well with record measurement. IN 1977, N.C. Jones P.S. #2934 recorded a LCRC, L.1820, P.330 indicating a 1" pipe in monument box and four accessories, two of which exist in 1998 and check very well with record measure. In the 1998 Remonumentation Program, I am finding a 1" iron pipe in centerline of Judd Road 147 feet West of the centerline of Saginaw Street 8" below surface. I am finding four accessories from the surveys of 1965 and 1971 which check very well. Also, the measurement of 147' as compared to 148.5' from the centerline of Saginaw Street indicates that and 1971 which check very well. Also, the measurement of 147' as compared to 148.5' from the centerline of Saginaw Street indicates that the corner has remained in the same position since 1922. Saginaw Street was probably gravel in 1922 accounting for the 1.5' difference in distance. I accept the found 1" pipe as the best available evidence of the original corner.
