Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1998 Remon

Re-established corner F-13 from Plat of Killarney Park No. 1. In 1815 Alex Holmes set corner F-13 40 chains west of corner G-13. No description of the object placed for this corner was called for, but two accessories were given, neither of which exist today. In 1921 the Genesee County Road Commission plans, drawing number 1153 show the section line, but give no indication of the corner F-13. In 1960, Genesee County Road Commission plans number 1535 show corner F-13 at the intersection of Maple Avenue and Killarney Park Drive, but give no description or witnesses to the corner. A measurement of 2694.5 (40 chains) from corner G-13 to F-13 is indicated. Field notes from the G.C.R.C., 1920's–1930's, and Rowe Inc. files indicate three accessories, but no object for corner F–13 is described. None of the accessories exist today in 1998. In the 1998 Remonumentation Program I am finding no object in place for corner F-13 and none of the accessories that were called for in the G.C.R.C. and Rowe field notes. The recorded Subdivision of Killarney Park No. 3, Liber 26, P. 7; Genesee County records indicate corner F-13 to be 9.85 feet west of the east line of Killarney Park Drive. In my field traverse of the south line of Burton Township T7N-R7E, I recovered Plat monumentation along the east line of Killarney Park Drive at the southeast corner of Shannon Road and Killarney Park Drive. I also found monumentation at the northeast corner of Belfast Street and Killarney Park Drive, and also at the northeast corner of Killarney Park Drive and Maple Avenue. I also found the monument at the southeast corner of Lot 130 and the monument at the southeast corner of Killarney Park No. 3. I reestablished corner F-13 by projecting the east line of Killarney Park Drive South utilizing the found monumentation, which measured 0.37 feet long of record, 50 feet south of the north line of Maple Avenue and running a straight line west from the corner G-1,T6N-R7E, and the projection of the east line of Killarney Park Drive South 9.85 feet west. From this reestablished position for corner F-13 to comer G-13 a distance of 2694.57 feet was measured as compared to the 1960 G.C.R.C. measurement of 2694.5 feet and the Platted record measurement from Killarney Park No.1, No.2, and No.3 of 2694.75 feet. From my field research, I have determined that comer F-13 is an obliterated corner and that it's position can be reestablished from the found monumentation within the recorded Plat of Killarney Park No.1 as has been indicated. Based upon the above information I accept the re-established position of the corner F-13 as the best available position for the original corner.

70.35' Set PK&tag 37276 in SW face PP N45°W

S50°W 66.74' Set spike&tag 37276 in SE face 10" triple Elm

S50°W 98.32' Set PK&tag 37276 in SE face PP

60.79' SE corner brick Killarney Park Sub.sign N15°E
