as is the distance E'ly, it is probably perpetuated since the GLO corner. The monumentation & accessories can be directly traced from 1890 to 1964. This corner shows a pattern for at least 100 years of recovery by the Co.Sur.&GCRC followed by perpetuation by new monumentation replacing the old after each paving project. The 1920 paying centered the 20 ft. wide conc. the sec. line making it a good accessory. The current accessories date to 1971 as well. I accept the 1/2" rerod as a faithful and careful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
