There is no reason for a road bed unless they had corners Both D-3 & X-3 were stones & date back over 120 years. This Both D-3 & E-3 were stones & date back over 120 years. This corners, as others, shows pattern of recovery & perpetuation by new monumentation by Co. Sur. & GCRC. The corner hasn't changed and I accept the 1972 recovered T-iron as a faithful and dareful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Also, I note a fnd. 1/2" rebar 285.60' to the east and used as a witness corner.
