

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

J3 - 1/4 corner common to Sections 2 & 11, T19N, R1W

- 1877 GLO Resurvey by Merrill set post for 1/4 sec cor 1) dead Pine 4" N32°W 24 lks. No other trees near.
- 1905 County Survey Records Knox planted a Cedar 2' X 2" X 2"
- 1977 LCRC page 156, P. B. Lapham, PS #9433 Set 1/2" capped re-rod. 2) South 35.80' Corner Post; 3) S45°W 61.61' 2nd post west; 4) N15°W 37.78' 1st post West

Miles, PS #47965 ... this corner was monumented as a re-establishment of the lost original GLO corner location by single proportionate method between the Southwest corner of Section 2 and the Southeast corner of Section 2... Set 1/2" X 24" rerod w/ co. cap #28417 - 5) N11°E 24" Maple 54.41'; 6) N55°E 30" Maple 77.73'; 7) N35°W 1/2" rerod 34.80'; 8) N30°W 6" Red Pine 62.56'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

<u>J3</u> - 1/4 corner common to Sections 2 & 11, T19N, R1W

No GLO or county surveyor evidence was found. Found a ½" rebar in approximate centerline of East-West gravel road per LCRC P. 156, and survey recorded in L. 3, P. 354. Also found a ½" CIR #28417 per LCRC, L.C1, P. 761. ½" rebar fits reasonably well between 13 and a found bolt at the E1/16 set by the Knox in 1905. Distance to 13 measures 2591.37'-grid (2609.64'-GLO, 2585.88'-knox). Distance to K3 measures 2591.18'-grid (2609.64'-GLO, 2585.88'-knox). Accepted the found ½" rebar as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner, and replaced it with a 3" stamped DNR Brass Cap on 5/8" x 34" long rebar with 4" x 6" long PVC pipe filled with concrete around cap.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

<u>J3</u> – 3" stamped DNR Brass Cap on 5/8" x 34" long rebar with 4" x 6" long PVC pipe filled with concrete around cap - Buried 0.6' below road bed surface.
