Based on physical evidence and Richardson's notes the 5/8" rebar is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
 - Reference Pt. Found ½" capped iron rebar #27595 per LCRC #500 is N8° 57'W 42.66' from 'D9'. This capped iron rebar fits Richardson's survey map numbers but it is apparent from the physical evidence that there is a blunder in Richardson's survey dimensions. ½" CIR #27595 not utilized as 'D9' in this survey.
