- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- E11 J. Mullett 1846 Set Post

Cedar 12" N85°E 10 L. Maple 12" S62°W 38 L.

- CCC Notes 1930's North between 32 & 33 80:00 Set Random post
- Lapham & Assoc. Notes R. L. Higgins 1978 Sec. 29 Fd. SE at 5331.44' from the SW. N85°E 6.6' Fd. stump; SE 20.23' spike in Maple Clp.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- E11 Section corner common to Sections 28, 29, 32 & 33, T20N, R2E Fd. ½" x 18" rebar 4' North of centerline of old overgrown E-W 2-track road probably from 1930's CCC Survey. Fits one Higgins Witness and the remains of the NE. Carl Kiiskila, PS and I both investigated the stump remains to ground at N85°E 6.6' from this ½" rebar and concluded the stp. was a Pine not a cedar. Could not accept Higgins iron as a original perpetuation. Couldn't find any other conclusive GLO evidence. Investigated GLO swamp calls from the ½" rebar and proportional distances as follows: 1) The ½" iron falls on the NW'ly edge of a swamp to the S & E and N. 2) To the NW is a transition zone between swamp and higher ground. GLO says "North 3 CH leave swamp". Swamp edge to N is mostly N-S so this is an inconclusive call. 3) GLO says "leave swamp – 1.16 West". Measured W 54'± 20' to edge of swamp transition zone. Also measure West 477'± 30' vs. 474' GLO to enter swamp. 4) Measured East 492'± 20' vs. 462' – GLO to "leave swamp". 5) Measure South 322'± 15' vs. 330' GLO to "leave swamp" and South 1189'± 30' vs. 1188' – GLO to "enter swamp". 6) The distance East is 5316.9' vs. 5287.9' - GLO to 'G11' and West 5336.9' vs. 5290.6' - GLO to 'C11'. 7) The distance South to 'E13' is 5115.8' vs. 5280' - GLO and North to 'E8' is 7948.6' vs. 7920' - GLO. Upon looking at all the evidence it appears the 1/2" iron rebar is located correctly N-S based on the GLO swamp calls South and the presence of the old CCC road. E-W the ½" iron is 8.6' East of a proportional E-W position. Could see no reason to move position 8.6' West since E-W swamp calls would probably indicate moving more East. Thus accepted ½" x 18" rebar as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- E11 Replaced ½" x 18" rebar with Stamped 4" DNR aluminum cap on 1" x 3' long galv. iron pipe N4°E 162.61' to set N & T in E. side 34" W. Pine scribed 'XBT' S42°E 20.12' to set N & T in NE side 20" R. Maple (RLH) S5°E 38.08' to set N & T in E Side 10" R. Maple scribed 'XBT' S39°W 44.39' to set N & T in NW side 13" R. Maple scribed 'XBT' N46°W 83.46' to set N & T in SW side 10" R. Maple Clp - 4 Set Blue Carsonite Post 1' West
