- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - Original corner established by Wells Burt U.S. Deputy Surveyor in 1851 Original bearing trees: Hemlock 20" S68°E 36 links Sugar Maple 12" S86° W 53 links
  - In 1964 Donald Lappala RLS 12585, restored corner position at record bearing and distance from the stump remains of the two original bearing trees. Corner position further verified by measurment to recoverable record natural features to the north. Lappala then set a 2" diameter by 5 foot long pipe with 3" bronze cap stamped: T44N, R39W; S-3, 5-4, 5-9, 5-10; RLS 12585; 1964 Rec L1, pg. 55. From which he established the following. - Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a 2" diameter iron pipe with 3" bronze cap set by Donald Lappala. Found bearing tree in good condition, a twin sugar maple and (2) reference objects which area power pole and wood sign post.
