- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Wells Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor on Sept. 1, 1851. Original bearing trees: Cedar 9" N16°E 10 links (6.60feet) Cedar 4" \$28°W 12 links (7.92 feet)

- Corner position monumented by E. Kazianka, RLS 14765 on 10/30/68; with a 1" diameter iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the corner location. He established the following new bearing trees: 7" sugar maple - N22°E - 254 feet. 7" sugar maple- S51°W - 6.5 feet
- Donald Lappala, RLS 12585 recovered Kazianka's monument on 8/25/70 and established new bearing trees: 10" Sugar maple N 48° W 15.7 feet

12" yellow birch - N 73°E - 24.2 feet (destroyed)

4" x 4" x 7" cedar post - S54°E - 3.8 feet (see reverse side)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
