A. Description of	original mon	nument and accessories and	d/or subsequent restoration:		

- Original survey by Austin Burt, D.S., in 1847. Set a post at 1/4 corner from which a W. birch 5" N67°E 14 links and a W. birch 5" N12°W 27 links.
- 1937 Corner restored by C.A. Walker, Engineer, and J.A. Jezek, RLS, as part of Gunderson's Plat of Crystal Lake. Set a 4" square concrete monument.
- 1962 Corner monumented by Donald Lappala, RLS, with the U.S.F.S. who set a 3" diameter brass capped stamped witness corner (iron pipe 2 1/2" dia.) - 0.26 feet south from the concrete monument found.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found the Lappala corner and concrete monument from Gunderson's Plat next to each other, both in good condition. The concrete monument checks with other monuments found in Gunderson's Plat and I am accepting it as marking the 1/4 corner as shown on the Plat.
