On 9/18/87, I restored the corner position by single proportionate measurement on line between the South quarter corner of Section 35 and the South quarter corner of Section 36, and set a 2" diameter by 30" aluminum pipe monument, 2" above ground surface, with a 3" aluminum cap stamped as follows: T44N, R39W, S-35, S-36, S-2, S-1; T43N; 1987; RLS 27457; from which I established the following blazed and scribed bearing trees: 1987 Bearing Trees:
