Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: In September 1851, Wells Burt set a post and established the following bearing trees: N3°E 16 links 10" Spruce S60°W 26 links 8" Spruce 7/7/70 - Donald Lappala, RLS restored the corner using C&NW RR Plans and MDOT Plans for HWY. 45. He also notes that he referenced the corner to the Plat of "The Village of Watersmeet". He set a brass capped pipe flush with the ground and recorded it in Liber 1, pg.57 with accessories as noted below.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

On June 3, 1997 I found the brass cap set by Lappala in 1970 in good condition and in the correct location checking with his ties. I have used this corner position in approximately 20 surveys of record for Govn't, commercial and private parties since 1978. This brass cap checks well with the Plat of the 1st Addition and the Wakefield Addition to Watersmeet, but is out of "sync" with the original Plat as shown on the sketch on the back. All plats date back to 1887± with reference to the corner. 1895 C&NW Plans show the corner on the westerly rail. 1951 MDOT plans call for the corner to be a nail and tag in a fish plate on a R.R. tie. I have accepted Lappalas corner as correctly set from the old R.R. plans and marking the 1/4 corner position.
