- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original survey by Wells Burt, D.S., who set a wooden post from which he established: 14" tamarack N16 E - 13 links and a 8" spruce - 53°W - 28 links.
 - 1945 MDOT Highway plans for a reroute of M-45 shows a 3" square cedar post at corner location with bearing trees: 6" tamarack - S25°E - 10.78 feet; 7" pine - S45°W - 14.61 feet; 5" tamarack - N40°W - 46.10 feet
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a 3"± squared 4' long cedar stake in a moss covered bog area. A finishing nail is in the top of the stake with a blazed 8" tamarack bearing N86'W - 36.12 feet. A 7" dead blazed spruce bears S57'W - 15.0 feet. This post location has been used and accepted by other surveyors for over 25 years, as per my discussions with other area surveyors. Measurements to available corners west and east check reasonably well as does the original swamp call west of 253.44 feet. I am accepting this post as the most probable loction of the original corner.
