

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Austin Burt 9/6/1851. Original bearing trees:

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Restored corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the bearing tree at N.59° W., It is now a very badly decayed 12"-16" broken cedar stump. This is the only old growth Cedar stump recovered within a 30' radius. No evidence remains from the original bearing tree at \$.53° E. Natural feature ties (swamp calls) north and south of the corner are in accordance with the field notes of the original Government survey.

C. Description of manument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 3/4" X 4' aluminum rod monument with a 3 1/4" stamped aluminum cap and the following new B.T.s (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree).
